

## Restarting

Dear Parents/Guardians,

ESBC has plans to restart Sunday School and Mid-Week activities for ESBC.kids. The tentative dates are September 2nd for Mid-Week activities and September 6th for Sunday School. Following is a list of safety and health procedures ESBC has decided to put in place.

### General Overall Changes

- All students participating in church activities must have a student information form filled out.
- Volunteer, student, and (if need) parent temperatures will be checked before entering facility or riding vans to church.\*
- If any student or student from a household has a temperature of 99.5 degrees or higher they or their household are asked to wait till the following week to attend \*
- As volunteer, student, and (if need) parent either get on van or enter the church building they will be asked either to apply hand sanitizer or wash their hands. \*
- If anyone from your students household has come in contact with a virus. We ask that the student not attend services until you know if is safe they attend. \*
- Minimalist approach in classrooms to reduce the cleaning needed.
- All toys in K, PreK, Nursery will be placed in cabinets. Toys will only be brought out on a needed basis. *(Only what you are willing to clean after each session.)*
- After activities end surfaces used will be sprayed or wiped down with disinfectant.
- All teachers that are at risk encouraged to stay at home.

### Specific to Sunday School

- When students arrive to church we will have them come in the entrance by the Nursery.
- Following Sunday school, 3rd thru 5th will go to sanctuary after class and Pre-K thru 2nd can stay for extended Kid's Church. 3 year olds in Pre-K will go to Nursery to join others there.

### Specific to Mid-Week Activities

- Only the double door entrance to fellowship hall will be available for students to enter when arriving and exiting.
- Vans will drive to youth room to pick up youth before leaving to drop off students.
